RULES BOOK

General Rules and Instructions

a. Registration

- The last date for registration form and fee submission for different activities is 23rd November 2018.
- Only bonafide students will be allowed to participate.

b. General Judgment Criteria

- Decision of the respected judges will be final and cannot be challenged.
- Themes and time limits will be followed strictly.
- Use of indecent language, derogatory remarks about national leaders, political parties, government agencies, religious sects and faculty are strictly prohibited.
- Any team or participant found involved in any type of cheating will be disqualified with immediate effect.
- Participants of all competitions are required to be present at the stated venue 30 minutes before the time as mentioned in the program.

c. Disqualifications

- Any institution's pictures/ artwork/ video exhibiting vulgarity or racism or religious discrimination will be disqualified.
- All routines, music, choreography and costumes must be suitable for family viewing. University reserves the right to deduct points, disallow or disqualify any act without assigning any reason, including those considered distasteful or vulgar.
- University expects that all competitors/participants will treat other participants, judges, and competitors with respect and represent themselves well. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from the event.
- Competitors must make no attempt to manipulate the rules and regulations to their advantage or to the advantage of any competitor.

- The following violation(s) may result in the immediate disqualification of the competitor from the competition:
 - Distracting or interfering with any competitor, who is preparing for, or attempting, an act.
 - Distracting or interfering with any official while they are carrying out their duties.
 - Failure to comply with the instructions of the official judges and/or the organizers.
- Any sort of abusive language is not allowed.
- Any team found to be employing unfair-means shall be disqualified immediately.
- Decision of judges shall be final and cannot be challenged. However, in case of any dispute, the convener of Student Affairs shall give the final verdict.

d. Department of the Year 2018 Award

Each winner will be given 1 point in each activity. The total points of faculty and students will be considered for awarding trophy of best department of the year award.

1. Qirat Competition

- Each participant will be given a maximum of 4 minutes to recite the verses from The Holy Quran.
- If a participant makes a mistake while reciting, and the mistake was corrected by the judges, the student will lose points.
- Similarly, if a student makes a mistake and fails to adhere to Tajweed rules, and the mistake is corrected by the judges, the student will lose points as well.
- No point will be deducted by the judges for any mistake in Tilawah, Hifdh or Tajweed if the student corrects himself/herself without the evaluator's help. The judges will give the student a chance for self-correction.

2. Naat Competition

- Naat should have a maximum of four verses.
- No repetition of verses will be made.
- Each participant will be allotted maximum 5 minutes to recite his/her selection.
- All recitations must be delivered by memory.
- The competitive assessment will be based on five factors: Quality of content , Correct pronunciation ,Confidence in delivery , Quality of memorization, Quality of recitation
- Tune must not copy or based on songs.

3. Bilingual Declamation Competition

- A speaker may speak for a minimum of four minutes and a maximum of six minutes. Marks will be deducted for failing to wind up within the stipulated time.
- Three prizes in each category will be awarded.
- Paper reading is not allowed. Any speaker violating this rule will be penalized.

- No speaker is allowed to pass derogatory remarks about national leaders, religious and social controversies, defence services, court of law or government agencies. Violation of this instruction shall lead to his/her disqualification from the competition and the speaker will be requested to leave the stage immediately.

4. Essay Writing

- The time of essay writing will be 1.5 hour.
- The evaluation will be based on content, flow, vocabulary, grammar, and originality of ideas.
- Consultation of any material during the competition is not allowed & will be tantamount towards disqualification.
- Essay should not be less than 1500 words.
- Extra time will not be given in any case.
- Sheets and pens will be provided by university.

5. Story Writing

- The time of story writing will be 1.5 hours
- The evaluation will be based on content, flow, vocabulary, grammar, and originality of ideas.
- Consultation of any material during the competition is not allowed & will be tantamount towards disqualification.
- No story should be less than 1500 words.
- Extra time will not be given in any case.
- Sheets and pens will be provided by university.

6. Urdu Poetry Competition

- Ghazal should be created according to the given TrhaMisra.
- The Nazm should fall under the given title.
- Nasri nazm will not be acceptable. Only azad nazm or paband nazm will be accepted.
- The poetry must be the original work of the participant.

- Ghazal to contain maximum of 5 verses.
- Maximum time for Nazm is 3 minutes.

7. Bait Baazi

- Each team will comprise of 03 members, otherwise team will not be allowed to participate in the competition.
- Each team will be given 30 seconds to respond, failing to do so will give the chance to next time.

8. Painting Competition

- The time of the competition will be 2 hours.
- Participants must bring their own paints, brushes, charts and sketching material.
- The paintings will be judged on the basis of innovation, originality, color combinations, visual appeal and relevance to the theme.
- Paintings will remain the property of university.

9. Sketching Competition

- The time of the competition will be 2 hours.
- Participants must bring their own sketching material and sheets.
- The paintings will be judged on the basis of innovation, originality, color combinations, visual appeal and relevance to the theme.
- Sketches will remain the property of university.

10. Calligraphy Competition

- The time of the competition will be 2 hours.
- Participants must bring their own paints, brushes, charts and sketching material.
- No more than 5 ayahs can be calligraphed.
- Participants should use known Arabic calligraphic scripts (e.g Nastaleeq, Thuluth, Naskh, Kufic, Ruqa'h, etc.) for their artwork.
- The calligraphic scripts must display uniformity, proportionality and consistency of lettering in accordance with the original Quranic text

- Artwork will remain the property of university.

11. E-Poster Competition

- Participant has to be submit the e-poster before 23rd November 2018 by emailing at studentaffairshuic@gmail.com.
- The poster should be submitted in jpeg format.

12. Photostory Competition

- Participants are required to narrate a story or an idea by using just the medium of photography.
- Each story may contain maximum of 5 photos along with name/title of the story only.
- The photo story should be self-explanatory and no words shall be used to explain the story.
- Size: 10×12 inches (Untreated; without frames but mounted on the black chart).
- Entries will be judged based on originality, creativity and relevance to the theme.

13. Best Selfie Competition

- Participants may submit group selfie only. Individual selfie or any inappropriate picture (or background) will be disqualified.
- The selfie should be pasted on black chart for display.

14. Best Baker Competition

- Participants should bring pre-baked items on the event.
- The judgement will be based on taste and presentation.
- The participants will be allowed to sell the items after judges have visited the stall.

15. Crafts Bazaar

- Participants can design any handmade item such as bags, jewelry, greeting cards, shoes etc.

- The participants will be allowed to sell the items after judges have visited the stall.

16. Sell your Idea

- The teams will present a unique idea. The judgement will be based on creativity, presentation and feasibility of the idea.

17. Drama Festival

- The teams have to submit script of the drama by 23rd November 2018 to focal persons of the departments.
- Based on the quality of synopsis and the script of the play, the teams will be shortlisted and conveyed by focal persons.
- No drama should be less than the minimum time limit (10 minutes)
- No drama should exceed the maximum time limit (20 minutes).
- Marks will be deducted in case of violation of time limits.
- For stage setting a maximum of 5 minutes will be provided prior to performance. If this limit is exceeded, the additional time will be counted in the performance.
- Judges are the ultimate authority and no one can challenge their decision.
- Participating teams are not allowed to portray any content in their performances which is below moral standards. Drama containing derogatory remarks/ abusive language will not be allowed and team will be disqualified.

18. Battle of Bands

- The team must comprise of a minimum of two and maximum of five members.
- Each band will be allotted maximum time of 5-7 minutes.
- Each band should prepare a mashup of a minimum 3 songs.
- The band should provide the music in USB by 30th November 2018 to focal persons.

- The judgement will be based on quality of voice and selection of songs.

19. Short Film

- No video should be less than the minimum time limit (4 minutes).
- No video should exceed the maximum time limit (7 minutes). Marks will be deducted for each extra minute.
- Winners will be selected by a panel of judges based on creativity, originality and relevancy Judges are the ultimate authority and no one can challenge their decision.
- Participating teams are not allowed to portray any content in their videos which is below moral standards.
- Animated videos will not be catered.
- Each team can comprise 3 members (director + editor + writer) at the most.
- Videos (Films / Documentaries) will be played on a multimedia projector (1200 X 800 pixels) and big screen (15 X 10 ft.); therefore they must be formatted on CD's / USB. No VHS recording will be entertained.
- The film should be provided by 30th November 2018 to focal persons of the event.

20. Mimicry

- Each participant has to mention the personality he/she is going to mimic on the registration form.
- No vulgar or abusive language should be used otherwise participant will be disqualified.
- The maximum time allowed for mimicry is 5 minutes. Points will be deducted for extra minutes.

21. Dubsmash

- No vulgar or abusive language should be used otherwise participant will be disqualified.

- The maximum time allowed for dusbmash is 5 minutes. Points will be deducted for extra minutes.
- The dusbmash should be provided to focal persons by 30th November 2018 in USB.

22. Computer Gaming

- Each player should mention the game on the registration form.
- For PUB-G, students should bring their own android phones.

23. Cricket

- International rules of cricket will be followed.
- The matches' planner for team will be displayed by 30th November, 2018.

24. Futsal

- Game format: 5v5.
- Standard futsal rules will be applied.
- Maximum of 8 players per team (5 playing and 3 subs).
- Rolling substitutions.
- Match time: 30 minutes (14 minutes half and 2 minute break).
- Only Gripper shoes will be allowed.
- No offside.
- In case of draw/ tie, 3 penalty kicks will be taken by each team.
- Goalkeeper will be allowed to pick up the back-pass.
- The matches' planner for team will be displayed by 30th November, 2018.

25. Badminton

- International rules of badminton will be followed.

26. Table tennis

- International rules of table tennis will be followed.

27. Ludo

- Standard ludo rules will apply.

28. Carom

- Standard carom rules will be applied.

29. Best Makeup

- The team should comprise of two members, the makeup artist and the model.
- 1.5 hours will be given to each team.
- The team will bring their own makeup and tools.

30. Best Hairstyle

- The team should comprise of two members, the hairstylist and the model.
- 1 hours will be given to each team.
- The team will bring their own hairstyling tools.

31. Best Henna

- The team should comprise of two members, the artist and the model.
- 1 hours will be given to each team.
- The team will bring their own henna tools.
